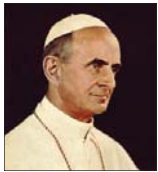

Pastor's Note

MARY MEDIATRIX OF ALL GRACES

In the midst of the “Marathon of Prayer” which Pope Francis has called for during this Month of May “*For the end of the Pandemic and the resumption of our social and economic life*”, we have the eloquent Scriptural image of Our Lady’s mediation with Christ on behalf of the Church during the nine-days of prayer before Pentecost: “*All these were persevering with one mind in prayer, with the women and Mary the Mother of Jesus, and with His brethren*” (Acts of the Apostles 1:14)

On the Day of Pentecost, when the Holy Ghost descended upon the disciples who were praying there in the Cenacle, according to Tradition the Holy Ghost first descended upon the Blessed Virgin Mary and then from her passed on to all of the others gathered in the room. This is most fitting as Mary was the one who was “*full of grace*” (Luke 1:28).

Both of these images are beautiful ones to sustain our own prayer in these days.

At the inauguration of this month-long prayer for deliverance, Pope Francis prayed:

Most loving Mother, grant that the sense of belonging to one great family, in the awareness of the bond that unites us all, might grow in the world; so that, with a spirit of fraternity and solidarity, we might come to the aid of the many people who are poor and the many situations of misery. Encourage firmness in faith, perseverance in service, constancy in prayer.

According to the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization:

Every shrine around the world is invited to pray, in the language and manner used locally, asking for the resumption of social life, work,

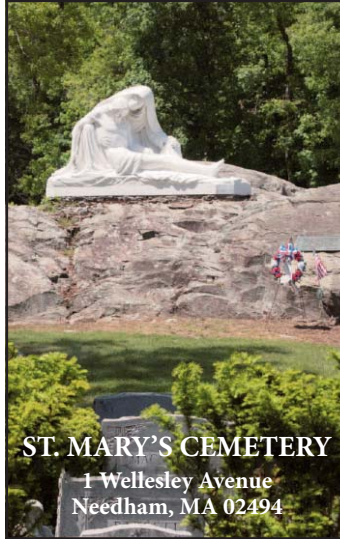

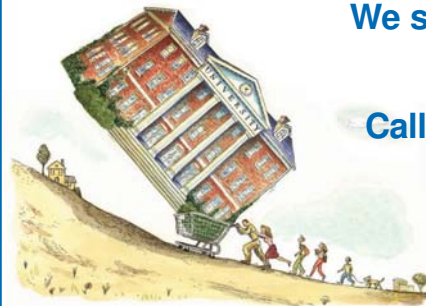

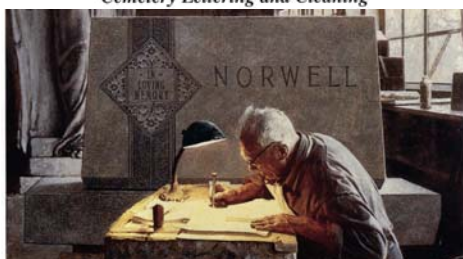
