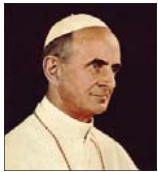

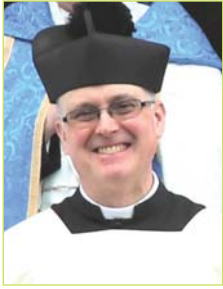

Pastor's Note

THE LORICA OF ST. PATRICK

The St. Patrick window of our parish church shows an important scene which touches upon the Mystery of today's

Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. The scene is the audience Patrick had with the High King of Ireland in his court at Tara on Easter Sunday, March 26th, A.D. 433. There, Patrick picked up a three-leafed shamrock to explain in some rough way the Mystery of God as Three-in-One. As a result of this, Patrick obtained from the High King permission to preach the Gospel the length and breadth of Ireland.

In preparation for the beginning of the mission to Ireland, which was fraught with every danger including the likely killing of Patrick and his missionary companions, the Saint is said to have composed the beautiful prayer we know as the Lorica (or the Breastplate) of St. Patrick. A metrical paraphrase translation was composed by Mrs. Cecil Frances Alexander (an Irish Protestant) in the 19th Century and this is set the music of the hymn "I Bind Unto Myself Today".

A literal translation of the old Irish text is as follows:

*I bind to myself to-day
The strong virtue of the Invocation of the
Trinity:*

*I believe the Trinity in the Unity
The Creator of the Universe.*

*I bind to myself to-day
The virtue of the Incarnation of Christ with His
Baptism,
The virtue of His crucifixion with His burial.
The virtue of His Resurrection with His
Ascension.
The virtue of His coming on the Judgment Day.*

*I bind to myself to-day
The virtue of the love of seraphim,
In the obedience of angels,
In the hope of resurrection unto reward,
In prayers of Patriarchs,
In predictions of Prophets,
In preaching of Apostles,
In faith of Confessors,
In purity of holy Virgins,
In deeds of righteous men.*

*I bind to myself to-day
The power of Heaven,
The light of the sun,
The brightness of the moon,
The splendour of fire,
The flashing of lightning,
The swiftness of wind,
The depth of sea,
The stability of earth,
The compactness of rocks.*

*I bind to myself to-day,
God's Power to guide me,
God's Might to uphold me,
God's Wisdom to teach me,
God's Eye to watch over me,
God's Ear to hear me,
God's Word to give me speech,
God's Hand to guide me,
God's Way to lie before me,
God's Shield to shelter me,
God's Host to secure me,
Against the snares of demons,
Against the seductions of vices,
Against the lusts of nature,
Against everyone who meditates injury to me,
Whether far or near,
Whether few or with many.*

*I invoke to-day all these virtues
Against every hostile merciless power
Which may assail my body and my soul,
Against the incantations of false prophets,
Against the black laws of heathenism,
Against the false laws of heresy,
Against the deceits of idolatry,
Against the spells, of women, and smiths, and
druids,
Against every knowledge that binds the soul of
man.*

*Christ, protect me to-day
Against every poison, against burning,
Against drowning, against death-wound,
That I may receive abundant reward.*

*Christ with me, Christ before me,
Christ behind me, Christ within me,
Christ beneath me, Christ above me,
Christ at my right, Christ at my left,
Christ in the fort,
Christ in the chariot seat,
Christ in the poop,
Christ in the heart of everyone who thinks of
me,
Christ in the mouth of everyone who speaks

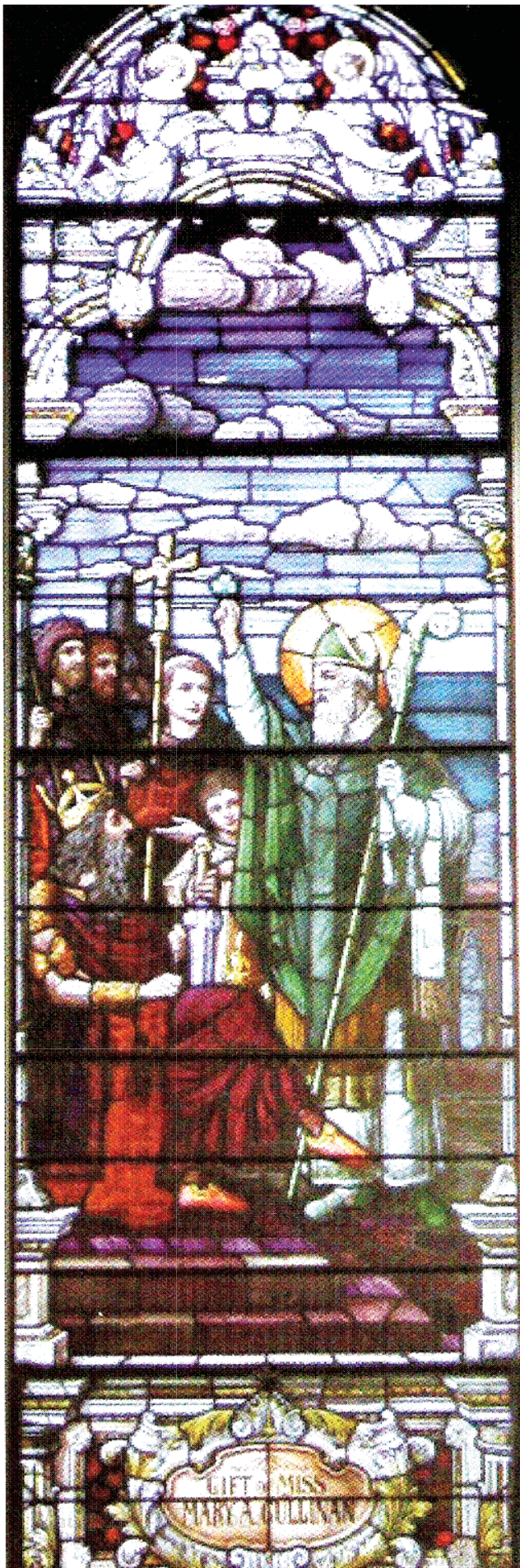

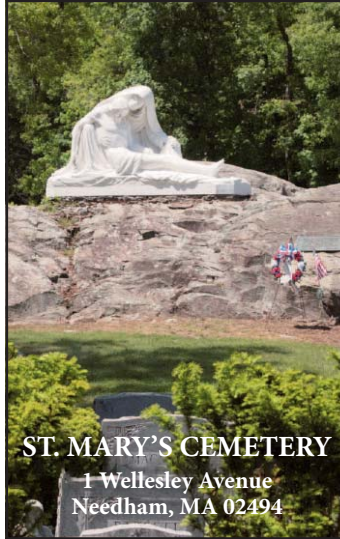

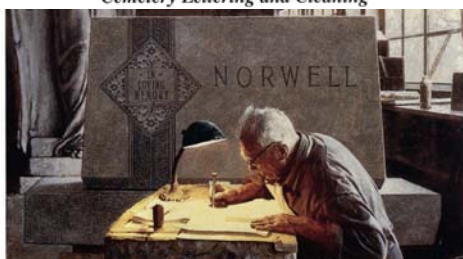
