LATIN MASS PROPERS: EIGHTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

INTROIT: Psalm 47:10-11. 2 We have received Thy mercy, O God, in the midst of Thy temple. according to Thy name, O God, so also is Thy praise unto the ends of the earth: Thy right hand is full of justice. Ps. Great is the Lord, and exceedingly to be praised in the city of God, in His holy mountain V. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT Grant us, we pray, Lord, in Thy goodness, the spirit to think and to do always what is right, so that we, who cannot exist without Thee, may be able to live according to Thy will. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

EPISTLE: Romans 8:12-17. Brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh; for if you live according to the flesh, you shall die; but if by the Spirit you mortify the deeds of the flesh, you shall live. For whosoever are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For you have not received the spirit of bondage again in fear, but You have received the spirit of adoption of sons, whereby we cry: Abba (Father). For the Spirit Himself giveth testimony to our spirit, that we are the sons of God; and if sons, heirs also; heirs indeed of God, and joint heirs with Christ.

GOSPEL: Luke 16, 1-9. **At** that time, Jesus spoke to His disciples this parable: “There was a certain rich man who had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods; and he called him, and said to him: ‘How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship, for now thou canst be steward no longer.’ And the steward said within himself: ‘What shall I do, because my lord taketh away from me the stewardship? To dig I am not able: to beg I am ashamed. I know what I will do, that when I am put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses.’ Therefore calling together every one of his master’s debtors, he said to the first: ‘How much dost thou owe my lord?’ But he said: ‘A hundred barrels of oil.’ And he said to him: ‘Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty.’ Then he said to another: ‘And how much dost thou owe?’ Who said: ‘A hundred quarters of wheat.’ He said to him: ‘Take thy bill, and write eighty.’ And the lord commended the unjust steward, for as much as he had done wisely: for the children of this world are wiser in their generation than the children of light. And I say unto you: Make unto yourselves friends of the mammon of iniquity, that when you fail, they may receive you into everlasting dwellings.”
