## OUR LADY OF KNOCK.

On the evening of August 21<sup>st</sup> 1879 on the outer gable wall of the Sacristy of the Catholic Church in the village of Knock, County Mayo, Ireland, was seen an extraordinary light, in the midst of which appeared the Blessed Virgin, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist. Behind them an Altar on which stood a Lamb, and above it the Crucifix, with the figure of our Lord upon it. The people soon gathered at the spot gazing rapturously on the Heavenly Vision. And crowds now visit the scene of the wonderful apparition bringing many lame and blind, who by touching the structure have been miraculously cured and restored to sight.

## LATIN MASS PROPERS: ELEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

**INTROIT:** Psalm 67:6-7; 36:2 GOD in His holy place; God who maketh men of one mind to dwell in a house; He shall give power and strength to His people. *Ps. ibid.* 2. Let God arise and let His enemies be scattered: and let them that hate Him flee from before His face. *Ÿ.* Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — God in His ...

**COLLECT** ALMIGHTY everlasting God, who in the abundance of Thy kindness art wont to go beyond our merits and our prayers: pour down Thy mercy on us: forgive us aught whereof our conscience is afraid, and grant us all we dare not ask in prayer. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.

**EPISTLE:** From the First Letter of Blessed Paul the Apostle to the Corinthians, 15. 1-10. **BRETHREN:** I make known unto you the Gospel which I preached to you, which also you have received, and wherein you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast after what manner I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all, which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures; and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures; and that He was seen by Cephas, and after that by the eleven. Then was He seen by more than five hundred brethren at once; of whom many remain until this present, but some are fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the Apostles. And last of all He was seen also by me, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the Apostles, who am not worthy to be called an Apostle, because I persecuted the Church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am; and His grace in me hath not been void.

**GRADUAL:** Psalm 27:7. IN God hath my heart confided, and I have been helped; and my flesh hath flourished again; and with my will I will give praise to Him. Unto Thee have I cried, O Lord: O my God, be not Thou silent: depart not from me. **ALLELUIA:** Psalm 80:2-3 Rejoice in God our helper: sing aloud to the God of Jacob, take a pleasant psalm with the harp. Alleluia.

**GOSPEL:** Continuation of the holy Gospel according to St. Mark, 7. 31-37. **AT THAT TIME,** Jesus going out of the coasts of Tyre, came by Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis. And they bring to Him one deaf and dumb, and they besought Him that He would lay His hand upon him. And taking him from the multitude apart, He put His fingers into his ears, and spitting, He touched his tongue; and looking up to heaven, He groaned and said to him: Ephpheta, that is, Be thou opened: and immediately his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke right. And He charged them that they should tell no man: but the more He charged them so much the more a great deal did they publish it; and so much the more did they wonder, saying He hath done all things well; He hath made both the deaf to hear, and the dumb to speak.
