#### THE SOLEMN TE DEUM ON TRINITY SUNDAY

The singing of the Solemn *Te Deum* on Trinity Sunday, as we are doing at our 9 AM and 11 AM Masses, is a way of expressing our praise and thanks to God on this Feast which celebrates the Trinitarian Mystery of God as He is in Himself: a Trinity of Persons in a Unity of Being. We praise God for His Excellence and we thank God for all of His many gifts and benefits to us, even as we are aware that we can never, ever praise or thank Him enough.



The *Te Deum* is also known as the *Ambrosian Hymn*, as it is attributed to the composition of St. Ambrose (+397). Let us be drawn in to the mystery of these great phrases: *Te Deum laudamus* ... *We praise Thee, O God, we acknowledge Thee to be the Lord: all the earth doth worship Thee: the Father* 

Everlasting. To Thee all Angels cry aloud: The Heavens and all the Powers therein. To Thee all the Cherubim and Seraphim continually do cry. Holy, Holy, Holy: Lord God of Sabaoth.
