This painting is the scene of the Call of St. Matthew to be an Apostle (St. Matthew’s Gospel, Chapter 9:9-13), even though he was engaged in the scandalously sinful profession of gathering the tax-tributes for the Romans, enriching himself by squeezing his own fellow Jews.

One of the intriguing questions about this painting is: Who is Matthew? Is it the older, bearded man who, startled, might be pointing his finger at himself as if to say, “Me?” Or is it the much younger man at the counting table, his head looking down at his money, before he has raised his eyes to Christ, and is the bearded man pointing his finger to ask, incredulous, “Him?”

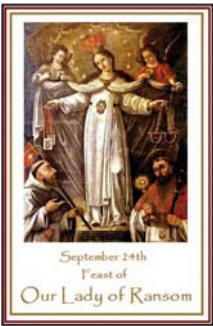

LATIN MASS PROPER: SAINT MATTHEW, APOSTLE AND EVANGELIST

INTROIT: Psalm 36:30-31, THE MOUTH of the Just Man shall meditate Wisdom, and his tongue shall speak judgment: the law of his God is in his heart. Ps. Be not emulous of evildoers: nor envy them that work iniquity. V. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — The mouth of the Just Man ...

COLLECT MAY WE be helped, O Lord, by the prayers of Blessed Matthew, Thine Apostle and Evangelist, that what we cannot obtain of ourselves may be granted to us by his intercession. Through Our Lord.

EPISTLE: From Book of the Prophet Ezekiel 1:10-14 AS FOR the likeness of the faces of the four living creatures: there was the face of a man, and the face of a lion on the right side of the four; and the face of an ox on the left side of all the four; and the face of an eagle over all the four. And their faces and their wings were stretched upward; two wings of every one were joined, and two covered their bodies; and every one of them went straight forward; whither the impulse of the spirit was to go, thither they went, and they turned not when they went. And as for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance was like that of burning coals of fire, and like the appearance of lamps. This was the vision running to and fro in the midst of the living creatures, a bright fire, and lightning going forth from the fire. And the living creatures ran and returned like flashes of lightning.

And the Pharisees seeing it, said to His disciples: "Why doth your Master eat with publicans and sinners?" But Jesus hearing it, said: "They that are in health need not a physician; but they that are ill. Go then, and learn what this meaneth: 'I will have mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I am not come to call the just, but the sinners."

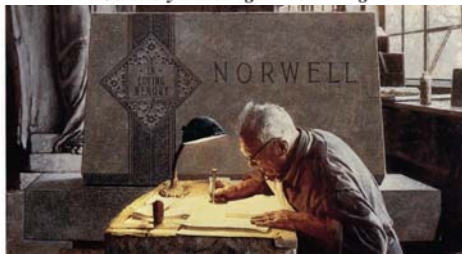

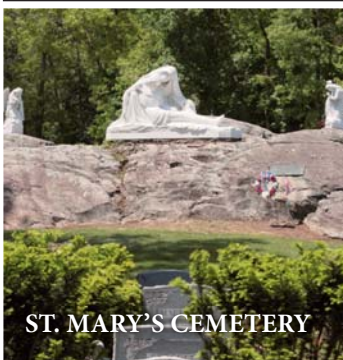
