



POPE PAUL VI AT THE UNITED NATIONS: OCTOBER 4th, 1965

As we have been following the speeches of the world's leaders at

the United Nations in the past two weeks we might do well to re-call this year's 60th Anniversary of Pope Paul VI's speech to the General Assembly on October 4th, 1965. Pope Paul's visit to New York October 4th-5th, 1965 was a much celebrated event. It was the first time a reigning Pope had visited the United States of America. The Pope celebrated an outdoor Mass at Yankee Stadium. It was also the first time a Pope had addressed what was then a very new institution: the United Nations. Twenty years after the founding of the UN and the end of that cataclysmic war history calls World War II, and only three years after the Cuban Missile Crisis which had brought the two super powers the U.S. and the Soviet Union to

COLLECT: O God, whose only-begotten Son by His Life and death and resurrection has won for us the rewards of eternal salvation, grant, we pray, that we who meditate on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE: Proverbs 8: 22-24, 32-35 The Lord possessed me in the beginning of His ways, before He made anything, from the beginning. I was set up from eternity, and of old, before the earth was made. The depths were not as yet, and I was already conceived. Now therefore, ye children, hear me: blessed are they that keep my ways. Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. Blessed is the man that heareth me, and that watcheth daily at my gates; and waiteth at the posts of my doors. He that shall find me, shall find life, and shall have salvation from the Lord.

Behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb and shalt bring forth a Son: and thou shalt call His name Jesus. He shall be great and shall be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God shall give unto Him the throne of David His Father: and He shall reign in the House of Jacob forever, and of His Kingdom there shall be no end. And Mary said to the angel: How shall this be done since I know not man? And the angel answering, said to her: The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee and the power of the Most High shall overshadow thee. And therefore also the Holy which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. And behold thy cousin Elizabeth, she also hath conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her that is called barren; because no word shall be impossible with God. And Mary said: Behold the handmaid of the Lord, be it done to me according to thy word.


