

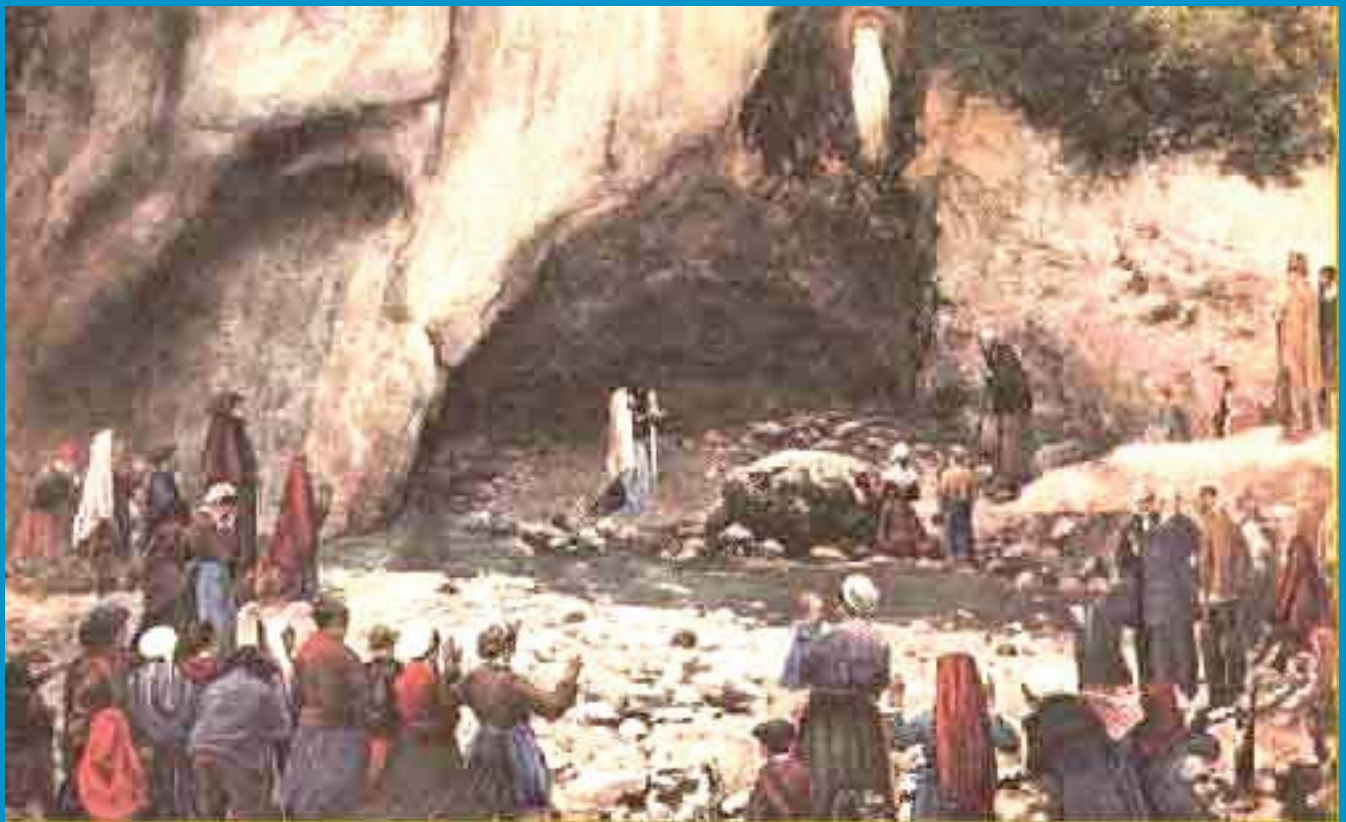

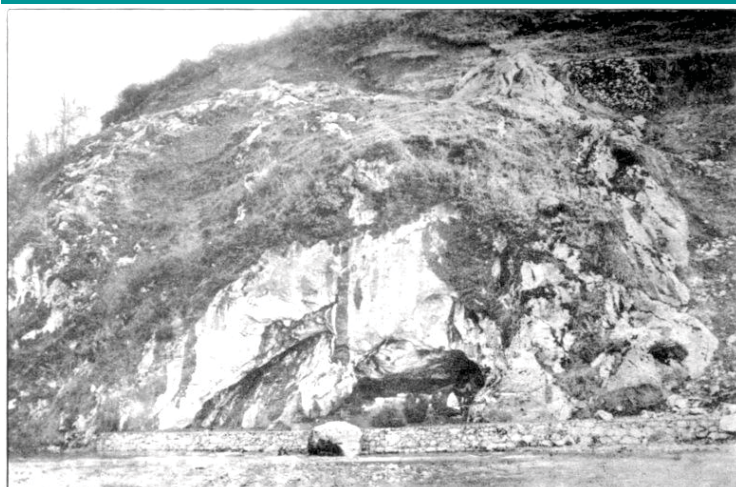

The 18 Apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary Immaculate to Saint Bernadette Soubirous, 1858.

February 11th: 1st Apparition, Thursday in Sexagesima Week.

February 14th: 2nd Apparition, Shrove Sunday.

February 18th: 3rd Apparition, Thursday-after-Ash.

February 19th-March 4th: The 4th-15th Apparitions occurred during the “Fortnight”, from Friday-after-Ash to Thursday of the Second Week in Lent. The Lourdes Spring was revealed on Thursday, February 25th.

March 25th: The 16th Apparition, The Feast of the Annunciation and Thursday in Passionweek. The Lady finally reveals her name: “I am the Immaculate Conception”.

April 7th: The 17th Apparition, Easter Wednesday.

July 16th: The 18th and final Apparition, on the Commemoration of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, the Feast of the Brown Scapular.

Ash Wednesday is a universal day of fast and penance in the Catholic Church. Abstinence from flesh meat is obligatory from the age of 14. Fasting (1 full meal, with two small meals permitted) is obligatory from 18-59.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

CURRENT DISCIPLINE

Days of Abstinence

Begins on one's 14th birthday.

Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.

Obliges abstinence from flesh meat.

Days of Penance

Applies to all the Faithful. Lent and Fridays outside of Lent.

Days of Fast

Everyone aged 18-59.

1 full meal permitted, two other meals may be taken which, when combined, are less than a full meal.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

(The obligation to do penance is lifted on Fridays which are also celebrated as a solemnity: e.g., Christmas Day).

OLDER DISCIPLINE

Days of Abstinence

Applies on one's 7th birthday.

Complete Abstinence on all Fridays of the year, Ash Wednesday, and the Vigil of Christmas.

Partial Abstinence (meat and soup, or gravy made from meat permitted once a day at principal meal) weekdays of Lent, Ember Days of Wednesday & Saturday, Vigils of Pentecost & Assumption. (Abstinence dispensed on Holy Days of Obligation.)

Days of Fast

Everyone aged 21-59.

Days of Lent from Ash Wednesday on, Ember Days, Vigils of Christmas, Pentecost and the Assumption.

One full meal permitted, with 2 smaller meals.

***MAIN CHURCH of MARY IMMACULATE
OF LOURDES***

***"KATHARINE DREXEL, Foundress of the Sisters
of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and
Colored People, was a woman of vision and
courage far ahead of her time. When she was
born, four years before President Lincoln
issued his Emancipation Proclamation,
4,000,000 Blacks were in slavery and some
300,000 Native Americans were living in
poverty and virtual bondage. Between the
years 1778-1868 the United States had made
394 treaties with the different Indian Nations
the perusal of which presents a flagrant
repetition of broken promises. These were the
downtrodden races of Americans that
Katharine Drexel, sensing sorrow, shame and
injustice, pledged her life and wealth to assist
and make free."***

LATIN MASS PROPERS:
APPARITION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY IMMACULATE AT LOURDES

INTROIT: Apocalypse 21: 2, Psalm 44: 2 I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. *Psalm.* My heart hath uttered a good word; I speak my works to the King. *V.* Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — I saw...

COLLECT: O God, who by the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin didst prepare a worthy habitation for Thy Son; we humbly beseech Thee, that we who celebrate the feast of the Apparition of the same holy Virgin, may obtain health of both soul and body. Through our Lord ...

EPISTLE: From the Apocalypse of St. John 11:19., 12: 1, 10 And the temple of God was opened in heaven; and the ark of His testament was seen in His temple, and

there were lightnings and voice, and an earthquake and great hail. And a great sign appeared in heaven: A woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. And I heard a loud voice in heaven saying: Now is come salvation and strength and the Kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ.

The program runs from June 22 to August 14, offering 8 weeks of activities.



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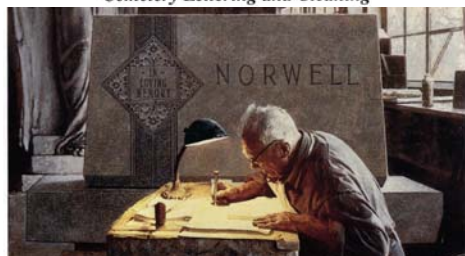
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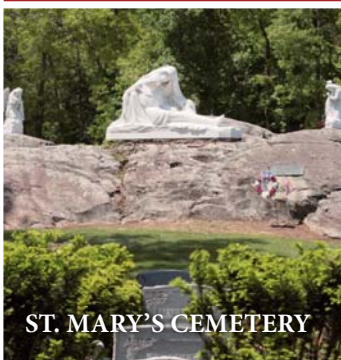
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
