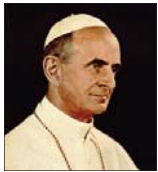

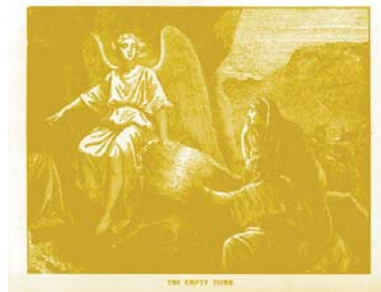

***The Finding of the True Cross by St. Helena,
Feast-day: May 3rd***

***“After the great victory gained over Maxentius by
the Emperor Constantine, under the standard of
Our Lord’s Cross, which had been miraculously
shown to him, Helena, his mother, was told in a
dream to repair to Jerusalem and search for the
True Cross. Upon her arrival, she ordered to be
taken down a marble statue of Venus, which had
been erected by the Pagans some hundred and
eighty years before, in order that all memory of Our
Lord’s Passion might be obliterated... The place
where the Cross was supposed to have been
excavated, three crosses were discovered at a great
depth below the surface: and with them, though not
attached, the Title that had been fastened to Our
Lord’s Cross. The doubt as to which of the three
crosses the Title belonged was removed by a
miracle. After having prayed to God, Macarius, the
Bishop of Jerusalem, applied each of the crosses to
a woman who was afflicted with a dangerous
malady. The first two produced no result: the third
was then applied and the woman was restored to
perfect health.”***

—Lesson from the Roman Breviary

LATIN MASS PROPERS: THE FINDING OF THE HOLY CROSS

INTROIT: Galatians 6:14 But it behooveth us to glory in the Cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in Whom is our salvation, life, and resurrection; by Whom we are saved, and delivered, alleluia, alleluia. Psalm 66:2. May God have mercy on us and bless us; may He cause the light of His countenance to shine upon us, and have mercy on us. V. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — But it behooves us ...

COLLECT: O God, Who in the glorious Finding of the Cross of salvation didst renew the wonders of Thy Passion; grant us by the price of the wood of life to win the palm of eternal life.

EPISTLE: From the Epistle of Blessed Paul the Apostle to the Philippians 2:5-11 Brethren, let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus: who being the in form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God; but emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant, being made in the likeness of men, and in habit found as a man, He humbled Himself, becoming obedient even to the death of the cross. For which cause God also hath exalted Him, and hath given Him a name, which is above all names: (*Here all genuflect*) that in the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those that are in heaven, on earth, and under the earth: and that every tongue should confess that the Lord Jesus Christ is in the glory of God the Father.

PASCHAL ALLELUIA: Psalm 95:10 Alleluia, alleluia. V. Say ye among the Gentiles, that the Lord hath reigned from the wood. Alleluia. Sweet the wood, sweet the nails, sweet the burden that hangs thereon: to bear the King and Lord of Heaven, no (tree) was worthy, save thou, (O Holy Cross). Alleluia.

GOSPEL: Continuation of the holy Gospel according to St. John 3:1-15 **At that time, there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. This man came to Jesus by night; and said to Him: Rabbi, we know that Thou art come, a Teacher from God; for no man can do these signs which Thou dost, unless God be with him. Jesus answered and said to him: Amen, amen, I say to thee, unless a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Nicodemus saith to Him: How can a man be born, when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born again? Jesus answered: Amen, amen I say to thee, unless a man be born again of water and the Holy Ghost, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh, is flesh; and that which is born of the spirit, is spirit. Wonder not that I said to thee: You must be born again. The Spirit breatheth where He will; and thou hearest His voice, but thou knowest not whence He cometh nor whither He goeth; so is every one that is born of the Spirit. Nicodemus answered, and said to Him: How can these things be done? Jesus answered and said to him: Art thou a Master in Israel, and knowest not these things? Amen, amen I say to thee, that we speak what we know, and we testify what we have seen, and you receive not our testimony. If I have spoken to you earthly things, and you believe not; how will you believe heavenly things? And no man hath ascended into heaven, but He that descended from heaven, the Son of Man Who is in Heaven. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up; that whosoever believeth in Him may not perish, but may have life everlasting. —**

OFFERTORY: Psalm 117:16, 17 The right hand of the Lord hath wrought strength, the right hand of the Lord hath exalted me; I shall not die, but live, and shall declared the works of the Lord, alleluia.

SECRET: Look down in mercy, O Lord, upon the sacrifice we offer Thee, and may it free us from all the evils of war; and destroying the snares of our enemies, may we, under the banner of the Holy Cross of Thy Son, be established in the peace of Thy protection. Through our Lord...

COMMUNION: By the sign of the Cross, deliver us from our enemies, O Thou our God, alleluia.

POSTCOMMUNION: Refreshed with food from heaven, and quickened with the spiritual cup, we beseech Thee, Almighty God, to save from the craft of the evil one, those whom Thou hast bidden to triumph by the wood of the Holy Cross of Thy Son, that chosen instrument of justice for the salvation of the world. 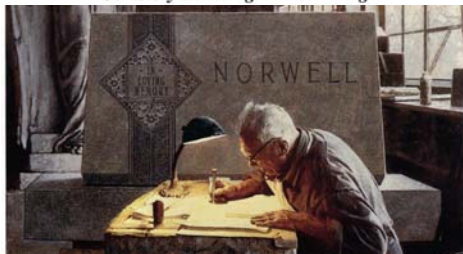

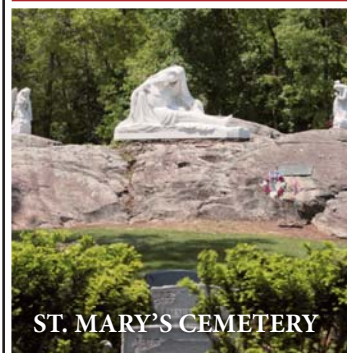
