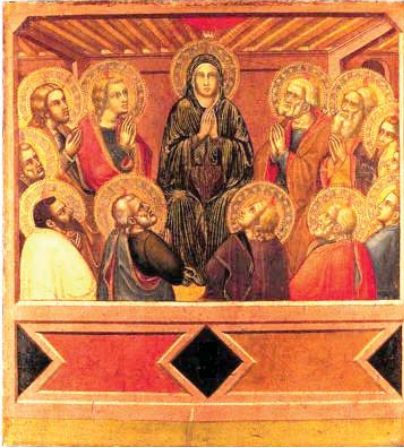

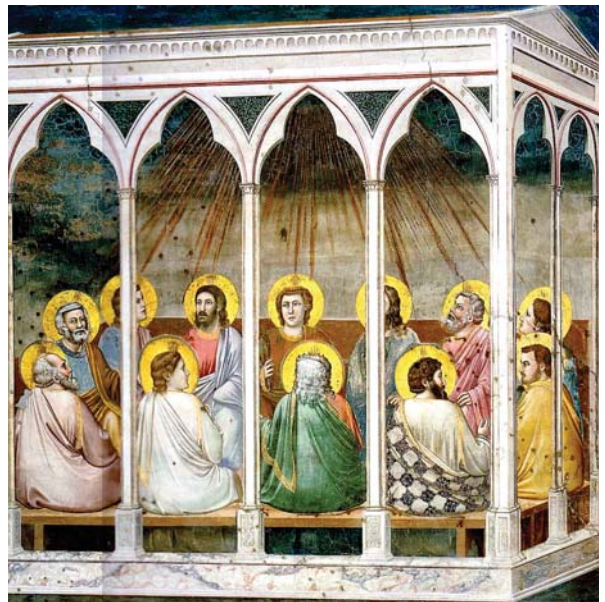

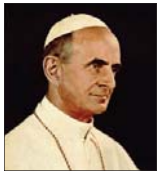


ABOUT OUR PARISH
