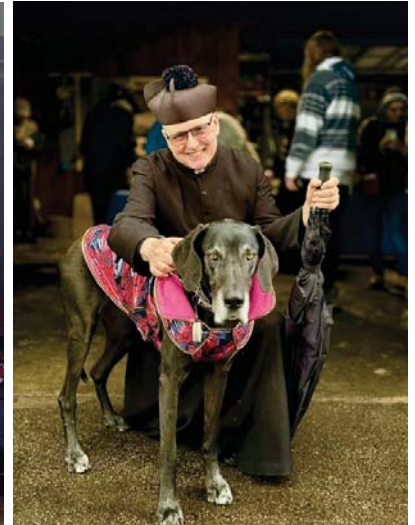

*The Eucharistic Miracle Reliquary of Lanciano, Italy:
The Miracle occurred ca. 700 A.D. Pope Paul VI permitted scientific testing of the relics, venerated for centuries as a Eucharistic Miracle. The results revealed the muscle tissue of a living human heart. Both the flesh and the blood were of Blood-type AB. Such is the evidence of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, tested by modern science nearly 1,300 years after the event.*

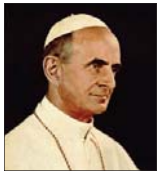


ABOUT OUR PARISH
